 - 3. [4:1-19] Sanctity in Suffering and Serving
 - a. [4:1-6] The SOURCE of Sanctified Living for the Glory of God
 - 1) [1-2] The HOW of Sanctified Living: Union with Christ
 - a) [1a] Therefore, since Christ has suffered in the flesh ,...
 - b) [1b] arm yourselves with the same way of thinking [via "unio mystica"]
 - i) [1c-2a] because he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin,
 - so as to live the rest of the time in the flesh no longer for the lusts of men...
 - ii) [2c] but for the will of God [cf., 2:24; Rom 6:1-13; 8:11-13]
 - This is not to be understood as sinless perfection [cf. | John 1:8, 10]
- > Is your heart desire to cease sin & do God's will or is it to do the desires of your heart?
 - 2) [3-6] Reasons to pursue sanctified living
 - a) [3-4] You've wasted enough of your life in days of your "BC" condition
 - i) [3] doing what pagans[lit., Gentiles] choose to do—living in debauchery, lust, drunkenness, orgies, carousing & detestable idolatry [cf, | Cor 6:9ff]
 - ii) [4] They are surprised that you do not join them in their reckless, wild living, and they heap abuse on vou
 - b) [5-6] There is an inescapable, universal Judgment Day looming ahead i) [5] they will give account to Him Who is ready to judge the living & dead
 - Mt 12:36f; Father: Mt 18:23; Son: Jn 5:22, 26-29; Acts 17:31; Ro 2:16
 - ii) [6] The only escape is by the Gospel: For this reason the gospel was also preached to those who are [now] dead, that they might be judged accord-ing to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit. [cf, Jn 5:25f]
- > Have you embraced Jesus Christ by faith as your personal Lord and Savior? Why wait?
 - b. [4:7-11] The WHAT of Sanctified Living: The SPECIFIC Fruit of Spirit
 - 1) [7] PRAYING: The end of all things is at hand [no other Redemptive Event before 2nd Coming]; therefore, be sound-minded and vigilant in your prayers
- > What does your prayer life indicate is the priority you put on prayer?
 - 2) [8-9] LOVING: Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, b/c love covers a multitude of sins. Be hospitable to one another w/o complaint.
 - 3) [10-11a] SERVING: Every Xn is "charismatic" As each has received a gift [charismata] & a "deacon" use it to serve [diakoneo] one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace: If speaking, as the oracles of God; if serving, as out of strength God supplies
- > How faithful a steward of God's grace to the Body are you being thru your gifted service
 - c. [4:11b] The WHY of Sanctified Living: so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ. to Whom belongs the glory & dominion forever & ever. Amen!
